LAPTOP CONNECTIVITY

Access to the Internet at PP-22 will be available using Wi-Fi:

- Wireless: IEEE 802.11a/n/ac/ax on 5 GHz and 802.11g/n on 2.4 GHz
 - Good performance is only guaranteed for 5 GHz and equipment which supports the latest WiFi features
 - o Throughout the whole PP22 Conference area
 - SSID: PP22 (Good performance is guaranteed)

PP22-legacy (for all, including old devices not supporting 5 GHz or latest Wi-Fi features)

 Open the browser and enter the username and password printed on your badge. Please do not share with others.
Maximum five devices per username.

Please note that the installation and use of non-ITU wireless access points without prior authorization from the ITU/IS Department is prohibited.

ANNEX 1

(to Annex to PP-22 Information for participants – IT facilities)

Notes on WLAN connectivity

To make the most efficient use of network resources, we strongly recommend the following:

- 1. Ensure that your user account has administrative privileges. Should you require help onsite, the ITU Service Desk staff will only be able to help you if you have administrative rights on your laptop.
- 2. Ensure that your wireless device has 5 GHz capability as good performance in high-density environment can only be guaranteed using 5 GHz. Connect to SSID "PP22" that operates exclusively on 5 GHz. If your device only supports 2.4 GHz or not supporting the latest Wi-Fi features (which gives better operability and performance), you may still connect to "PP22-legacy", unfortunately performance cannot be guaranteed, particularly during plenary sessions or crowded areas, due to limitation of the technology.
- 3. You are kindly requested to test your wireless connection well before the opening session.
- 4. Download the Conference documents before entering the meeting room.
- 5. By default, the wireless radio is always on, even when you are not surfing the Internet. Please turn it off to free up capacity and reduce interference to others.
- 6. Set Operation mode to "Infrastructure" (not Ad-Hoc or peer-to-peer). Refrain from using peer-to-peer connections as it creates problem, which affects all participants in the room.
- 7. Use default network parameters, e.g. enable DHCP, use default DNS, web-proxy set to "automatically detect settings".

Security

Please be aware that network communication can be intercepted, end-to-end encryption is recommended for confidentiality.

Always keep your firewall enabled. Note that firewall software configurations may prevent access to local resources (e.g. printers), you need to configure exceptions to allow access.

All wireless users must have a good anti-virus program that has up-to-date virus database. Viruses can easily spread in the wireless network.


Submission of proposals Official documents IT tools for delegates

 - Proposals from Member States
 - Minutes of Plenary meetings
- · Administrative documents (ADM): calendar, programme, agendas, etc. English only
- . Information documents (INF): for information only, not for discussion English only
- Temporary documents (DT): working documents published in original language only, unless it contains input to the Final Acts
- Temporary documents Limited distribution (DL): draft working documents with limited audience published in original language only




3 Downloading multiple documents at once

In each document list it is possible to select multiple documents using the checkboxes on the left side or the "Check All" button at the bottom. Then the selected documents can be packed into a "zip file" to be downloaded at once, using the "Zip and Download" button.

The zip file is automatically created from:

- the selected documents;
- any existing addenda and corrigenda; and
- associated html pages (similar to the ITU webpages)

in the chosen languages and formats.



The user has the option to select the formats and languages to be downloaded.

4 Laptop synchronization with the ITU website

The ITU PP-22 Synchronization Tool allows Delegates to synchronize PP-22 documents from the ITU servers to their local (Windows or Mac) laptop drive. It has been configured to access the ITU Server in Geneva (or on local server when available) and synchronize on demand to the latest published documents.
